Welcome Pack

Dear Mr xxxxxxxx

We are writing to you from the Children and Family Court Advisory and Support Service, also known as Cafcass. We are contacting you because an application has been made to the Court in relation to (Child Name 1) and (Child Name 2). The Court has asked us to find out more about your family situation so that we can help them make decisions that are safe and, in the children's best interest.

#### Who we are:

We work with children and their families in family court proceedings. Our responsibilities include making sure that your children are safe, that their welfare is promoted, that their voices are heard, their needs, wishes and feelings are known and are at the heart of what we say to the court in our reports.

Each family and child are guided through this process by a Family Court Adviser, who also makes recommendations to the court about what they consider to be in the best interests of children in proceedings. They gather information by listening to and meeting adults involved in the proceedings to understand the situation for them. They also seek information from the police and local authorities to see if there is any further information available that may help them understand whether children are safe, have been harmed or are at risk of further harm.

## What happens next:

You will receive an Appointment Letter from your Family Court Adviser. The purpose of the appointment will be for the Family Court Adviser to find out more about your family's situation and to answer any questions you might have about the process. This is referred to as a Safeguarding Interview.

They do not need to speak to (Child 1 Name) and (Child 2 Name) at this stage because the child arrangements programme which is set down by the family court does not allow this to happen before the first court hearing.
